1. Thiru. M. Rajendran, Velur (Namakkal) has filed an appeal petition before the Electricity Ombudsman on 23.11.2012 against the order dt.20.10.2012 of the CGRF of Namakkal EDC. The appeal petition was received at the office of the Electricity Ombudsman on 26.11.2012 and registered as Appeal Petition No. 50 of 2012.

2. The CGRF of Namakkal EDC in its order dt.20.10.2012 has ordered that a sum of Rs.20,620/- has to be paid by the appellant towards average current consumption charges and Rs.41,980/- towards penalty for not maintaining the power factor.

3. The appellant prayed to set aside the orders of the CGRF of Namakkal EDC and requested to revise the assessment for the meter defective period.

4. A copy of the appeal petition was forwarded to the SE/Namakkal EDC on 26.11.2012 for filing his counter . The respondent has filed his counter vide his letter dt.18.1.2013.

5. Hearings were conducted before the Electricity Ombudsman on the above subject on 22.1.2013 and 27.2.2013. During the second hearing conducted on 27.2.2013, after a detailed discussion, the representatives of both the appellant and the respondent informed that they have narrow down their difference and there is a feasibility to settle the issue amicably and hence need some more time to finalise the issue.

6. The appellant in his letter dt.5.4.2013 informed that based on the agreement reached between the Chairman, CGRF and him, a sum of Rs.16,976/- has alone to be paid by the him towards the audit amount . He has paid Rs.15,650/- vide receipt no.762235, dt.20.11.2012 (being the 25% amount deposited with the licensee while filing the appeal petition) and Rs.1326/- vide receipt no.0141160, dt.4.4.2013, thus Rs.16,976/- has been paid by him. Inview of the above, he has requested the Electricity Ombudsman to cancel his appeal petition.

7. As the appellant himself has requested to cancel the appeal petition, the appeal petition No.50 of 2012 is treated as closed.
